

## **Senior Center Transportation Information**

The Transportation Program is funded by the Regional Planning Commission Area Agency on Aging (AAA) and has been in operation for over 20 years. The program assists Pecos residents with their transportation needs as a way to help senior residents who because of health or financial reasons who can no longer drive a vehicle to get to their doctors' appointments, go grocery shopping, or if they just want to visit a friend.

The Senior Center offers transportation for eligible 60+ Pecos residents

- provides a lift-equipped bus for transporting individuals to medical appointments and non-medical destinations
- Destinations must be within the Pecos City limits
- **Medical appointments receive priority scheduling**
- must schedule Reservations for transportation service to medical appointments at least one business day in advance. Please note, we cannot transport outside of the listed times. If your appointment runs later, you need to arrange other means of transportation.
- REMINDER: we are not a medical transport. If needed, please contact an ambulance service or call 911.
